John Prine recorded "Angel from Montgomery" on his eponymous debut, but it was Bonnie Raitt's cover of the song and their ensuing duet that brought it to the masses. When they play the song together, Prine strums root-position chords in E, while Raitt straps on a capo at the second

fret and fingerpicks in dropped-D tuning. The arrangement below shows both parts. Follow along with the upper set to play Prine's part, or try the lower part in parentheses to play Raitt's.
