

Loudon Wainwright's paean to summer fun, "The Swimming Song," first appeared on Attempted Mustache, the follow-up to his breakthough 1972 recording, Album III. "The record I made after Album III was different," he says.

"The record company said they wanted another single, because after 'Dead Skunk' the door was just wide open; and I had kind of an ambivalence about it. But I had written a song called 'The Swimming Song.' I made that record [Attempted Mustache] in five days with Bob Johnson in Nashville. We were excited by that record. It was a great song, despite the fact that it didn't have a chorus and it had two flailing five-string banjos on it." Wainwright also recorded it on the live Career Moves, from which this guitar-centric version is taken.


