

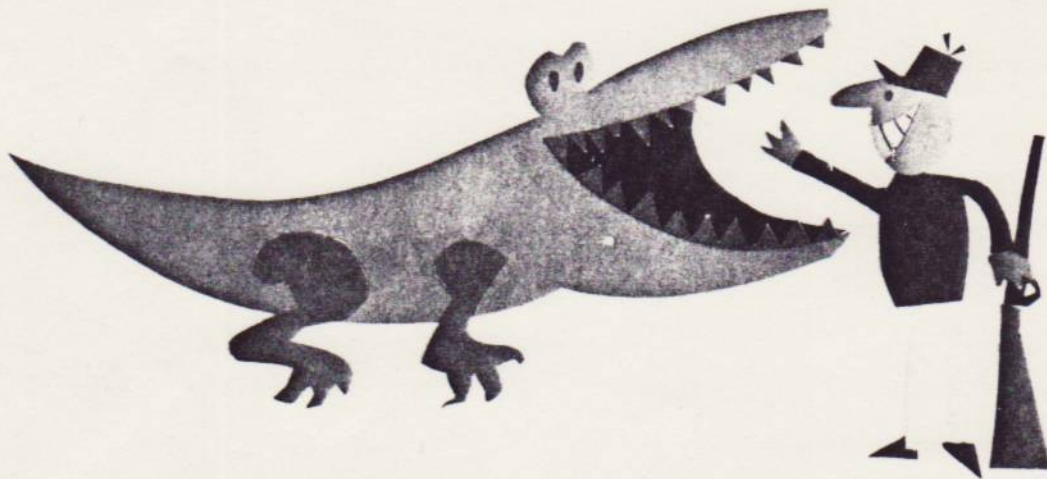
A-Hunting We Will Go
