
A bittersweet reflection on memories, relationships, and squandered potential, "Elderly Woman Behind the Counter in a Small Town" began for Pearl Jam as an acoustic demo (a solo-acoustic guitar rendition can be found on the B-side of the "Go" single) and has since grown into an enduring fan favorite. Once described by frontman Eddie Vedder as the

"longest title in the Pearl Jam catalogue," the song is now known to many simply

as "Elderly Woman" or "Small Town." The best-known recording of the song includes the entire band (with then-drummer Dave Abbruzzese) and appears on the group's second LP, Vs.

Lyrical content aside, the song is a relatively upbeat strummer in 6/8 time. The chords are wide and jangly, with the G note ringing out on top for most of the song. As you play each verse, keep your ring finger planted on the third-fret D using that position as a reference point to inform your other fingers. As written, the G/B chords synthesize the movement of Jeff Ament's bass guitar, but you can easily include the low G note for the sake of variation or a fuller, bassier sound.
