U2 reinvented its sound on 1991's Achtung Baby, and "One" is the standout anthem that holds this record together. At this point, U2's lyrics had moved from the political to the personal, but "One" encompasses both.

Follow the strumming pattern below, making sure to palm mute the roots of each chord on beats one and three, while

letting the higher strums on beats two and four ring out. In the first verse, try playing

partial chords, leaving out the top string or two (and the thumb-fretted bass note F), as in the recording, and try a Dsus2 (instead of D) on occasion. To sound more like U2 guitarist The Edge, embellish the chorus chords by briefly removing your middle finger from the C and Fmaj7 chords and your ring finger from the Am chord. You may also want to try walking down from C to Am to F on the chorus, another move The Edge worked into the record. Be sure to try the electric riff over the first verse—it will sound great on an acoustic guitar, too.
